

## Conditions of Entry for 2018 - Art Section

1. The annual Murray Music and Drama Club (MMDC) Stars of Tomorrow Talent Quest will be held this year from 7.30pm at the Pinjarra Civic Centre, Pinjarra Road on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> August for the 15-18 years and 19-25 years age groups and from 9am Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> August for the 5-8 years, 9-11 years and 12-14 years age groups. Entries close Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2018.
2. The Showcase Final will be held at the same venue starting at 7.30pm Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> August for presentation of certificates and prizes.
3. The MMDC's Stars of Tomorrow Talent Quest is open to residents of the Peel Region (Murray, Boddington, Waroona, Mandurah, Serpentine-Jarrahdale), as well as the Rockingham and Kwinana areas, for persons aged between 5 and 25 years of age inclusive as at Friday 24<sup>th</sup> August 2018.
4. Art Section entries can be any form of artwork eg painting, drawing, sketches, printed digital art, sculpture etc. using any medium.
5. All entries must be original works of art.
6. Paintings, drawing and sketches or printed digital art must not exceed A2 in size. Sculptures must not exceed 50cm x 50cm wide at base level.
7. Entrants may only enter one piece into the competition.
8. Entries must be brought to the Pinjarra Civic Centre, Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> August between 6pm and 8pm.
9. The cost of entering the Stars of Tomorrow Talent Quest, art section is \$10.00. This also allows entrants to attend all sessions throughout the weekend. Entry fees can be paid by cash, cheque, money order or direct deposit and forwarded with a completed entry form to Stars of Tomorrow Talent Quest, The Murray Music and Drama Club, PO Box 68, Pinjarra, 6208. Direct deposits can be made into BSB 036171 Account 112909 with the entrant's name as a reference. All refunds are at the discretion of the organisers.
10. Winners from each age group will be selected by a People's Choice voting system. Additional award/s will be selected by a guest adjudicator.
11. The vote count and decision of the adjudicator will be final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
12. No photographs are allowed to be taken of any of the art pieces. Any photos taken by the official photographer may be ordered during the day. The organisers reserve the right to use any photos for advertising purposes.
13. All entrants will receive an Artist Participant Certificate. All winners will be announced during the Showcase Finals on 25<sup>th</sup> August and therefore all entrants are encouraged to attend to receive their results.
14. Entrants are entitled to have one family member or support person attend the adjudication heats and Showcase Finals for free.
15. Accompanying friends and family members are required to pay for a ticket. Adults are \$10.00 and children (17 years and under) are \$5.00. This entitles them to attend all heats and the Showcase Final.
16. Refreshments including tea, coffee, sandwiches, drinks and snacks will be available for sale from the kiosk during the day, and at the interval during the Showcase Finals.
17. All entry fees, tickets and kiosk proceeds go towards meeting the administrative costs of running the event. No staff are paid. The event is completely staffed by volunteers, supporters and sponsors.
